Sunday Junior Hockey at BB&N

Skills and Scrimmages, Ages 7–14

This season, the club's junior members will have their own hour and a quarter of ice on Sunday afternoons at BB&N. Depending on player turnout, the ice will be divided into two or three cross-sections:

- *Skills clinic with Jordan Ross.* Jordan is a former youth hockey and high school varsity player, who has experience coaching girls' and boys' hockey. He will customize each session to the ages and skill levels of the skaters. Jordan will be teaching Power Skating during the time period before Junior Hockey.
- *One or two cross-ice scrimmages organized by age and skill level.* These games will be supervised by Junior Hockey coordinator, Jordan Ross, with assistance from parents and older junior members.
