Dear Members,

Winter may be a long way off, but it's time to renew your Cambridge Skating Club membership for the 2010–11 season. Please complete the attached form and return it, along with a check for your dues. All outstanding charges from the 2009–2010 season must be paid before your membership can be renewed. *Please note that dues have not been increased.*

Membership Categories

Family Membership – \$365

Two adults and all children under 25 years of age.

Junior members turning 25 before September 1, may join as individual members by submitting a separate renewal form with dues payment. Letters of recommendation are not required for junior members changing to adult member status.

Individual Membership – \$245

Inactive Membership – \$100

Members may elect inactive status only if they: (1) will be living out of state during the skating season or (2) have no children under age 18. Inactive members may skate three times per season and are welcome to attend all special non-ice events. Inactive members will not receive skate tags; they are asked to introduce themselves to the manager on duty when they skate. Inactive members may switch to active status (individual or family) during the skating season by paying the appropriate balance plus the late fee.

Honorary Membership – No dues

Honorary members are elected by the Board of Incorporators in recognition of service to the club.

Late Fee on Renewals Postmarked after June 30, 2010

Renewals postmarked after June 30 must include the \$50 late fee.

Renewals Postmarked after August 14, 2010

Please note that renewals postmarked after August 14 will be placed at the end of the wait list (according to the date received). We cannot guarantee that you will be offered a membership for the coming season if you do not renew by August 14, 2010.

Nonrenewals

If you do not plan on renewing your membership, please contact us (by reply email, if possible) so that we don't send you unwanted reminders.

Volunteers Are Needed (Sign Up in the Fall)

Look for an email in early November regarding the season's special events – children's parties, potlucks, and more. The club's special activities depend on volunteers. When you receive the call-to-volunteer email, please consult your calendar and volunteer for at least one event.

Membership Proposals

Clubhouse Rentals

One of the privileges of club membership is the option of renting the clubhouse for special events. The clubhouse is available for rentals to CSC members through the spring, summer, fall, and part of the winter. Given the short ice season, we do not rent the clubhouse from December 15 to February 15, except on a short-term basis, i.e., no more than five days ahead and only when the weather forecast indicates that there is no prospect of skating.

Rentals are \$100 per hour for members and \$125 per hour for non-members renting with a CSC-member sponsor. (Please note that the sponsoring member must be present throughout the event.) There is a two-hour minimum for rentals plus a service charge. Reserving a date requires a refundable \$500 deposit and signed application.


